Calhoun County Board of Supervisors meeting on August 17, in Rockwell City consisted of secondary road updates from Engineer Ron Haden. Mary Gidel also brought the board up to date on South Twin Lakes DNR's proposed Shallow Lakes Initiative Project. The board had previously presented a letter to the DNR on behalf of Mary Gidel's firm stand that South Twin Lake be left alone or placed under the restoration program that

would include both North and South Twin Lakes. Gidel presented photos of Diamond Lake, a lake that had similarities to South Twin Lake and was in the process of Shallow Lakes Initiative Project; having been drained and starting to fill back. The photos were to show what the lake looks like during the process of the project. The board has received no response to the letter, so it was decided that correspondence would be sent out again. DNR held a meeting on Thursday August 20, at Dolliver State Park Lodge in Lehigh

and will hold another on August 25 at 7 p.m. at the Pocahontas Expo Center; to speak about Lizard Lake as a DNR Lake Initiative. Legislators Dave Tjepkes and Daryl Beall are scheduled to be present.

On other matters; the first reading of ordinance #2009 -1; ordinance establishing a local option sales and service tax within the unincorporated areas of Calhoun County and the Calhoun County Portion of the City of Lytton.
