The timing of your question is amazing. DNR Fisheries and DNR Wildlife actually held a meeting today to discuss future management of North Twin and South Twins Lake. The plan is to hold a community meeting on July 28<sup>th</sup> to initiate a discussion about potential management/restoration activities and clear up any misconceptions that any individuals may have regarding the project. The project is in the early stages of development (study the system, collect historical information on the water bodies and watershed and present concepts that may work for improving the resource). Any implementation is at least two years away.
